NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of the **decision** of Kilkenny County Council to close the following public roads in Kilkenny City to **vehicular** traffic on **Tuesday, 17th March, 2026** in order to facilitate the St. Patrick's Day Parade and associated events.

John Street Upper (from Dublin Road to junction with Michael Street/ Maudlin Street)	9.00am to 4.00pm	Central Access Route or Ring Road
John Street Lower incl. John's Bridge (from Michael Street/ Maudlin Street to Batemans Quay)	9.00am to 6.00pm	Central Access Route or Ring Road
Rose Inn Street (from Batemans Quay to The Parade)	9.00am to 9.00pm	Central Access Route or Ring Road
Castle Road (from The Parade to Nuncio Road)	9.00am to 9.00pm	Bennettsbridge Road/Ring Road/Waterford Road. Local Access will be accommodated.
Patrick Street (from The Parade to Ormonde Road)	9.00am to 9.00pm	Ormonde Road/New Street/Dean Street/Central Access Route

Parliament Street/Irishtown (from Market Yard to Dean Street)	1.00pm to 4.00pm	Ormonde Road/New Street/Dean Street/Central Access Route Access to Market Cross Car Park will be maintained.
Market Yard/Batemans Quay (from Parliament Street to John's Bridge)	11.00am to 6.00pm	Central Access Scheme
